Dear Lord Reay,

I have been reading, with interest, your “Wind Turbines (Minimum Distances from Residential Premises)” Bill and strongly support your efforts. Of course, I have an interest in that there is a plan to erect a 330kW turbine (220ft overall height) within 1.1km of where I live (there are neighbours living less than 1 km from the site with one less than 300m). I am concerned by the noise of this machine and also its visual impact in a sparsely populated area of Devon with distinctive small hill top villages and farmsteads. From this Grade II listed building the turbine would be visible (appearing at approximately the same height as the tower) alongside our Grade I listed parish church.

I fear that many similar applications for the piecemeal development of individual turbines are in the pipeline in order to get any applications passed before your bill has a chance of becoming law.

I would be very pleased to hear from you as to the progress of this bill and also as to how those with similar views can help you in this cause.
